



EASY CABLE MITTENS

Cable mitten made from cuff to finger on one long circular needle (ala the Magic Loop Way)

Directions:

For Cuff

Cast on 42 stitches and divide onto two needles.

K1tbl, p1 around for 2.75 inches

Next round: increase 2 stitches evenly for a total of 44 stitches

Right Mitten

CABLE INFO: make cable forward every 7 rounds

Set Up Round:

Needle 1 k7, p1, k6, p1, k7

Needle 2: knit all

Begin Thumb Gusset rounds:

Round 1:

Needle 1: k7, p1, k6, p1, k6, place marker, M1R, k1

Needle 2: knit 1, MIL, place marker, knit remaining

Round 2:

Needle 1: k7, p1, k6, p1, k6, slide marker, knit to end.

Needle Knit to marker, slide marker, knit to end.

Round 3:

Needle 1: k7, p1, k6, p1, k6, slide marker, M1R, knit to end

Needle 2: knit to marker, M1L, slide marker, knit to end.

Repeat rounds 2 and 3 until there are 16 stitches between stitch markers don't forget to cable to front every 7th round)

Next round:

Needle 1: repeat established pattern on needle 1 to last stitch before marker, M1R, knit 1, remove marker and slide gusset stitches to waste yarn.

Needle 2: slide gusset stitches to waste yarn, remove marker, k1, M1L, knit to end

Next rounds:

Needle 1: Continue in established pattern remembering to cable stitch every 7th round.

Needle 2: knit all

Repeat this until the mitten body measures 5 inches (do not count your cuff in this measurement)

Finished Sizes:

Ladies Adult size Medium

Needles:

Size 5 or to give gauge of 6 stitches per inch

Yarn:

Worsted weight

Additional Materials:

stitch markers
tapestry needle
waste yarn

Decrease Rounds:

You will continue in established pattern except for the decrease area (do not forget to cable every 7th round)

Round 1:

Needle 1: k1, ssk, knit established pattern to last 3, k2tog, k1

Needles 2: k1, ssk, knit to last 3, k2tog, k1

Round 2:

Needle 1: knit established pattern

Needle 2: knit all

Repeat rounds 1 and 2 until there are a total of 32 stitches remaining on needles then begin a decreasing every round until there are a total of 12 stitches remaining. Graft together and sew in ends.

Left Mitten

CABLE INFO: make cable back every 7 rounds

Set Up Round:

Needle 1: knit all

Needle 2: k7, p1, k6, p1, k7

Begin Thumb Gusset rounds:

Round 1:

Needle 1: knit to last stitch, place marker, M1R, k1

Needle 2: k1, M1L, place marker, k6, p1, k6, p1, k7

Round 2:

Needle 1: knit to marker, slide marker, knit to end

Needle 2: knit to marker, slide marker, k6, p1, k6, p1, k7

Round 3:

Needle 1: knit to marker, slide marker, M1R, knit to end

Needle 2: knit to marker, M1L, slide marker, k6, p1, k6, p1, k7

Repeat rounds 2 and 3 until there are 16 stitches between stitch markers (don't forget to cable to back every 7th round)

Next round:

Needle 1: repeat established pattern on needle 1 to last stitch before marker, M1R, knit 1, remove marker and slide gusset stitches to waste yarn.

Needle 2: slide gusset stitches to waste yarn, remove marker, k1, M1L, knit to end

Next rounds:

Needle 1: Continue in established pattern remembering to cable stitch every 7th round.

Needle 2: knit all

Repeat this until the mitten body measures 5 inches (do not count your cuff in this measurement)

Decrease Rounds:

you will continue in established pattern except for the decrease area (do not forget to cable every 7th round)

Round 1:

Needle 1: k1, ssk, knit to last 3, k2tog, k1

Needles 2: k1, ssk, knit established pattern to last 3, k2tog, k1

Round 2:

Needle 1:

Needle 2: knit established pattern

Repeat rounds 1 and 2 until there are a total of 32 stitches remaining on needles then begin a decreasing every round until there are a total of 12 stitches remaining. Graft together and sew in ends.

Thumb for both

Slide all gusset stitches onto needle and remove waste yarn. Leaving a long tail knit evenly around until thumb measures 1.5 inches.

K2tog around

Repeat for a second round.

Using a tapestry, break off yarn, draw through tightly and weave in ends. Sew up hole left at thumb base.

Special Stitches

M1L: Bring the tip of the left-hand needle under the strand between stitches, from front to back. Knit through the back of the loop.

M1R: Bring the tip of the left-hand needle under the strand between stitches, from back to front. Knit this loop.

Cable to front: Slide 3 stitches to cable needle, hold to front, knit 3 stitches, knit 3 stitches from cable needle

Cable to back: slide 3 stitches to cable needle, hold to back, knit 3 stitches, knit 3 stitches from cable needle
