



FLOWERZ IN MY GARDEN

A stranded hat pattern using worsted weight yarn.

Directions:

Cast on 96 stitches. Join to make a circle being careful not to twist your stitches.

Purl 2 rounds

Knit 1 round.

Brim

Round 1 & 2: p1, k2 around

Round 3 & 4: p1, k1 around

Repeat rounds 1-4

Round 9 k all

Round 10 & 11 p all



Hat Band

Knit 1 round

Follow color chart

Knit 1 round

Crown

Round 1 & 2: purl

Round 3: knit

Round 4: knit 10, k2tog, place stitch marker, repeat around. There will now be 11 stitches between each marker. Placing a marker where indicated is not a necessity for this pattern. It sure makes it easier to remember where to decrease though ☺.

Round 5: knit

Round 6: knit to 2 stitches before marker, k2 tog, repeat around.

Switching to dpns when necessary, repeat rounds 5 and 6 until 2 stitches between each marker, then k2tog all around (8 stitches).

Break off yarn and using tapestry needle, thread needle through remaining stitches and pull tightly. Weave in all ends.

Enjoy.

Finished Size(s):

One size fits most: Circumference 22"

Needles:

Size 6 (US) 16 inch circular knitting needle plus dpns in same size or a long circular if doing magic loop method
Adjust needle sizes if necessary to obtain gauge
Smaller needle to pick up stitches

Yarn:

1 ball (100 grams) worsted weight yarn

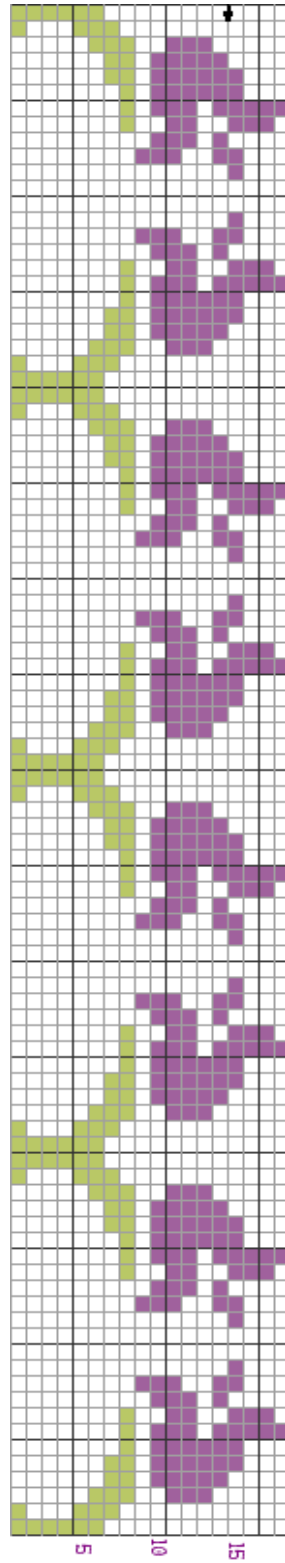
Additional Materials:

stitch markers
tapestry needle
waste yarn

Gauge:

Gauge 20 sts and 24 rows = 4 inches in stockinette
