



THE LACE LIEUTENANT

Head hugging beanie pattern in worsted weight yarn.

Directions:

Cast on 88 stitches. Join to make a circle being careful not to twist your stitches.

Knit 1 round

Purl 1 round

Main Body

Round 1: *k3, yo, k1, yo; repeat from * around

Round 2: knit

Round 3: * sl 1 (as if to purl), k2tog, pss0, *k3, * around to last 1 st, k1

Round 4: knit

Repeat rounds 1-4 until hat measures 4 inches ending on round 4

Crown Shaping

Round 1: k9, k2tog around

Round 2 (every even round) k all

Round 3: k8, k2tog around

Round 5: k7, k2tog around

Round 7: k6, k2tog around

Round 9: k5, k2tog around

Round 11: k4, k2tog around

Round 13: k3, k2tog around

Round 15: k2, k2tog around

Round 17: k1, k2tog around

Round 18: k2tog around

Break off yarn and using tapestry needle, thread needle through remaining stitches and pull tightly. Weave in all ends.

Enjoy.



Finished Size(s):

One size fits most: Circumference 24"

Needles:

Size 4.50mm/Us size 7 16 inch circular knitting needle plus dpns in same size or a long circular if doing magic loop method

Adjust needle sizes if necessary to obtain gauge

You may also choose to use a smaller size needle for a smaller hat.

Yarn:

1 ball (50 grams) worsted weight yarn

Additional Materials:

stitch markers

tapestry needle

waste yarn

Gauge:

4-5 stitches per inch

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
