



CABLED FORCE

Head hugging beanie pattern in worsted weight yarn.

Directions:

Cast on 90 stitches. Join to make a circle being careful not to twist your stitches.

K1, p1 around for 1 1/2 inches

Brim & Hat Band

Rounds 1, 3, 5: *(k1, p1) twice, K6, repeat from *

Rounds 2, 4, 6, 8: *(p1, k1) twice, K6, repeat from *

Round 7: *(k1, p1) twice, sl next 3 sts to cable needle and hold in front, K3, then K3 from cable needle, repeat from *
Repeat rounds 1-8 2 more times (or until desired length) ending on round 7

Last round before crown shaping: p1, k1, around

Crown Shaping

Round 1: k8, k2tog around

Round 2 (every even round) k all

Round 3: k7, k2tog around

Round 5: k6, k2tog around

Round 7: k5, k2tog around

Round 9: k4, k2tog around

Round 11: k3, k2tog around

Round 13: k2, k2tog around

Round 15: k1, k2tog around

Round 16: k2tog around

Break off yarn and using tapestry needle, thread needle through remaining stitches and pull tightly. Weave in all ends.

Finished Size(s):

One size fits most: Circumference 22"

Needles:

Size 4.50mm/Us size 7 16 inch circular knitting needle plus dpns in same size or a long circular if doing magic loop method

Adjust needle sizes if necessary to obtain gauge

Yarn:

1 ball (50 grams) worsted weight yarn

Additional Materials:

stitch markers

tapestry needle

waste yarn

Gauge:

4-5 stitches per inch

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
