A Woven and Spun Creation



this letter was stitched together without flipping right side

Materials

Worsted Weight Yarn

Size I Crochet hook (a smaller hook will produce a tighter stitch and smaller letter)

Polyester Fiber Fill

Stitch Markers

Special Stitch Information: Double Foundation Chain - - chain 2, work one single crochet in the first chain made. Insert the hook under the left-handed thread of the last single crochet made, work another single crochet. Repeat step 2 as required. (this stitch will be done later in the project)

This letter is worked from the bottom up in 3 sections.

Make 2

Section 1

You will work from the bottom up

Ch 16

Row 1 sc in first ch from hook and in each ch to end (15 sc) ch1, turn throughout

Row 2 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. 2 sc in last 2 sc (19 sc)

Row 3 2 sc in first 4 sc. sc in each sc to last 4 sc. 2 sc in last 4 sc (27 sc)

Row 4 2 sc in first 3 sc. sc in each sc to last 3 sc. 2 sc in last 3 sc (33 sc)

Row 5 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (35 sc)

Row 6 2 sc in first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. 2 sc in last 2 sc (39 sc)

Row 7 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (41 sc)

Row 8 2 sc in first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. 2 sc in last 2 sc (45 sc)

Row 9 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (47 sc)

Row 10 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (49 sc)

Row 11 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (51 sc)

Row 12 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (53 sc)

Row 13 sc in each sc across (53 sc)

Place marker in first sc on row 13

Row 14 2 sc in first sc. sc in next 24 (26 sc)

Row 15 Dec over first 3 sc. sc in each sc to last sc. (24 sc)

Row 16 2 sc in first sc. sc each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (24 sc)

Row 17 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (23 sc)

Row 18 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to end (23 sc)

Row 19 sc in each sc across (23 sc)

Row 20 2 sc in first sc. sc each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (23 sc)

Row 21 sc in each sc across (23 sc)

Row 22 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to end (24 sc)

Row 23 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (23 sc)

Row 24 sc in each sc across. (23 sc)

Row 25 sc in each sc to end. 2 sc in last sc (24 sc)

Row 26-39 sc in each sc to end (24 sc)

Row 40 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (23 sc)

Row 41 sc in each sc to end (23 sc)

Row 42 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (24 sc)

Row 43 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (23 sc)

Row 44 sc in each sc to end (23 sc)

Row 45 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (23 sc)

Row 46 sc in each sc across (23 sc)

Row 47 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (23 sc)

Row 48 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (24 sc)

Row 49 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (24 sc)

Row 50 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. 2 sc in last 2 sc (26 sc)

Finish off

Section 2

Return to marked stitch in row 13

Row 14 Join with sc in first stitch sc again in same stitch and sc in next 24 sc (26 sc)

Row 15 Dec over first 3 sc. sc in each sc to last sc. (24 sc)

Row 16 2 sc in first sc. sc each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (24 sc)

Row 17 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (23 sc)

Row 18 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (23 sc)

Row 19 sc in each sc across (23 sc)

Row 20 2 sc in first sc. sc each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (23 sc)

Row 21 sc in each sc across (23 sc)

Row 22 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to end (24 sc)

Row 23 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (23 sc)

Row 24 sc in each sc across. (23 sc)

Row 25 sc in each sc to end. 2 sc in last sc (24 sc)

Row 26-39 sc in each sc to end (24 sc)

Row 40 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (23 sc)

Row 41 sc in each sc to end (23 sc)

Row 42 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (24 sc)

Row 43 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (23 sc)

Row 44 sc in each sc to end (23 sc)

Row 45 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (23 sc)

Row 46 sc in each sc across (23 sc)

Row 47 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (23 sc)

Row 48 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (24 sc)

Row 49 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (24 sc)

Row 50 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. 2 sc in last 2 sc (26 sc)

Finish off

Section 3

Return back to the beginning of last row completed

Row 51 sc in each sc to end. Work Special stitch for 3 stitches and sc in each sc on last row worked in section 1. work to end (55 stitches)

Row 52 dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. dec over last 2 sc (53 sc)

Row 53 dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. dec over last 2 sc (51 sc)

Row 54 dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. dec over last 2 sc (49 sc)

Row 55 dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. dec over last 2 sc (47 sc)

Row 56 dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. dec over last 2 sc (45 sc)

Row 57 dec over first 3 sc. sc in each sc to last 3 sc. dec over last 3 sc (41 sc)

Row 58 dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. dec over last 2 sc (39 sc)

Row 59 dec over first 3 sc. sc in each sc to last 3 sc. dec over last 3 sc (35 sc)

Row 60 dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. dec over last 2 sc (33 sc)

Row 61 dec over first 2 sc. dec over next 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 4 sc. dec over next 2 sc. dec over last 2 sc. (27 sc)

Row 62 dec over first 3 sc. dec over next 3 sc. sc in each sc to last 5 sc. dec over next 3 sc, dec 2 over last 2 sc (19 sc)

Row 63 dec over first 3 sc. sc in each sc to last 3 sc. dec over last 3 sc (15 sc)

Finish off weave in all ends.

Instructions for an "invisible seam"

When done with both letters, lay one on top of the other. You will be working the "wrong sides" so if you want one color for the front and a different one for the back, place the back color on top of the front color. Slip stitch or whip stitch around. Leave a small opening to stuff fiberfill. Stuff firmly. Close opening.

For the seam shown above,

Lay O's on top of each other and slip stitch around leaving a small opening for the stuffing. Once firmly stuffed, close opening.
