\*this letter was stitched together without flipping right side out\*

### Materials

Worsted Weight Yarn

Size I Crochet hook ( a smaller hook will produce a tighter stitch and smaller letter)

Polyester Fiber Fill

Stitch Markers

This letter is worked from the bottom up in 2 sections.

### Section 1

Worked from bottom up

Ch 6

Row 1 sc in first ch from hook and in each ch to end ch 1, turn throughout (5 sc)

Row 2 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last 2 sc (7 sc )

Row 3 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (9 sc )

Row 4 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (11 sc )

Row 5 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc across (12 sc)

Row 6 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc across (13 sc)

Row 7 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (15 sc)

Row 8 sc in each sc across (15 sc)

Row 9 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (17 sc)

Row 10 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc across (18 sc )

Row 11 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc across (19 sc)  
Row 12 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc across (20 sc)  
Row 13 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc across (21 sc)  
Row 14 sc in each sc across (21 sc)  
Row 15 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (23 sc)  
Row 16 sc in each sc across (23 sc)  
Row 17 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (25 sc)  
Row 18 sc in each sc across (25 sc)  
Row 19 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc across (26 sc)  
Row 20 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc across (27 sc)  
Row 21 sc in each sc across (27 sc)  
Row 22 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (29 sc)

Row 26 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (32 sc)  
Row 27 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (33 sc)  
Row 28 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (34 sc)  
Row 29 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (35 sc)  
Row 30 sc in each sc across (35 sc)  
Row 31 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc across (36 sc)  
Row 32 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc across (37 sc)  
Row 33 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc across (38 sc)  
PM in first stitch on row 33  
Row 34 sc in first sc and in next 21 sc (22 sc)  
Row 35 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (22 sc)  
Row 36 sc in each sc across (22 sc)  
Row 37 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. 2 sc in last 2 sc (22 sc)  
Row 38 sc in each sc across (22 sc)  
Row 39 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (23 sc)  
Row 40 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (22 sc)  
Row 41 sc in each sc across (22 sc)  
Row 42 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc across (23 sc)  
Row 43 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc across (22 sc)  
Row 44 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc across (23 sc)  
Row 45 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc across (22 sc)  
Row 46 sc in each sc across (22 sc)  
Row 47 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (22 sc)  
Row 48 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc across (23 sc)  
Row 49 sc in each sc across (23 sc)  
Row 50 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc. (23 sc)  
Row 51 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (24 sc)  
Row 52 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc across (25 sc)  
Row 53 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. 2 sc in last 2 sc (28 sc)

Row 54 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc. (30 sc)  
Row 55 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (32 sc)  
Rows 56-59 sc in each sc across (32 sc)  
Row 60 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (31 sc)  
Row 61 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (29 sc)  
Row 62 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (27 sc)  
Row 63 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (25 sc)

Finish off

## Section 2

Return to stitch marker placed on row 33

Row 34 sc in first sc and in next 13 sc (14 sc)  
Row 35 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in eac sc across (13 sc)  
Row 36 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (13 sc)  
Row 37 sc in each sc across (13 sc)  
Row 38 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (13 sc)  
Row 39 sc in each sc across (13 sc)  
Row 40 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (13 sc)  
Row 41 sc in each sc across (13 sc)  
Row 42 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (12 sc)  
Row 43 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (13 sc)  
Row 44 sc in each sc across (13 sc)  
Row 45 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (13 sc)  
Row 46 sc in each sc across (13 sc)  
Row 47 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (13 sc)  
Row 48 sc in each sc across (13 sc)  
Row 49 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (14 sc)  
Row 50 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (13 sc)  
Row 51 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (14 sc)  
Row 52 2 sc in first 2 sc. sc in each sc across (16 sc)  
Row 53 2 sc in first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. 2 sc in next 2 sc. (20 sc)  
Row 54 2 sc in first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (23 sc)  
Row 55 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (25 sc)  
Rows 56-59 sc in each sc across (25 sc)  
Row 60 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (24 sc)  
Row 61 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (22 sc)  
Row 62 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (20 sc)  
Row 63 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (18 sc)

### Instructions for an "invisible seam"

When done with both letters, lay one on top of the other. You will be working the "wrong sides" so if you want one color for the front and a different one for the back, place the back color on top of the front color. Slip stitch or whip stitch around. Leave a small opening to stuff fiberfill. Stuff firmly. Close opening.

For the seam shown above,

Lay v's on top of each other and slip stitch around leaving a small opening for the stuffing. Once firmly stuffed, close opening.
