this letter was stitched together without flipping right side

Materials

Worsted Weight Yarn

Size I Crochet hook (a smaller hook will produce a tighter stitch and smaller letter)

Polyester Fiber Fill

Stitch Markers

This letter is worked from the bottom up in 2 sections.

Make 2

Section 1

You will work from the bottom

Ch 25

Row 1 sc in first ch from hook and in each ch to end (24 sc) ch1, turn throughout

Row 2 2sc in first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. 2 sc in last 2 sc (28 sc)
Row 3 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (30 sc)
Row 4 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (32 sc)
Row 5 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (34 sc)
Row 6-10 sc in each sc to end (34 sc)
Row 11 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (32 sc)
Row 12 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (30 sc)
Row 13 Dec over first 3 sc. sc in each sc to last 3 sc. Dec over last 3 sc (26 sc)
Row 14 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (24 sc)
Row 15 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (22 sc)
Row 16-34 sc in each sc across (22 sc)
Row 35 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (23 sc)
Row 36 2 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (25 sc)
Row 37 sc in each sc to end (25 sc)
Row 38 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc. (27 sc)
Row 39 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc. (29 sc)
Row 40 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc. (31 sc)
Row 41 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc. (33 sc)
Row 42 sc in each sc across (33 sc)
Row 43 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc. (35 sc)
Row 44 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc. (37 sc)
Row 45 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc. (39 sc)
Place marker in first sc on row 45
Row 46 sc in first sc and in next 24 sc (25 sc)
Row 47 Dec over first 3 sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (24 sc)
Row 48 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to end (25 sc)
Row 49 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (25 sc)
Row 50 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc. (25 sc)
Row 51 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. 2 sc in next to last sc. 3 sc in last sc (28 sc)
Row 52 3 sc in first sc. sc in each sc across (30 sc)
Row 53 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (31 sc)
Row 54 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (33 sc)
Row 55 sc in each sc across (33 sc)
Row 56 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (34 sc)
Row 57-59 sc in each sc across (34 sc)
Row 60 dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (32 sc)
Row 61 dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (30 sc)
Row 62 dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (28 sc)
Row 63 dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (26 sc)
Finish off

Section 2

Return to marked stitch in row 45

Row 46 2 sc in first sc. sc in next 12 sc (14 sc)

Row 47 dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (14 sc)

Row 48 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. dec over last 2 sc. (14 sc)

Row 49 dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (14 sc)

Row 50 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. dec over last 2 sc. (14 sc)

Row 51 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (15 sc)

Row 52 3 sc in first sc. sc in each sc across (17 sc)

Row 53 sc in each sc to last sc. 3 sc in last sc (19 sc)

Row 54 3 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (22 sc)

Row 55 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (24 sc)

Row 56 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc across (25 sc)

Row 57-59 sc in each sc across (25 sc)

Row 60 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. dec over last 2 sc (23 sc)

Row 61 dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc across (22 sc)

Row 62 dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. dec over last 2 sc (20 sc)

Row 63 dec over first 3 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. dec over last 2 sc (17 sc)

Finish off

Instructions for an "invisible seam"

When done with both letters, lay one on top of the other. You will be working the "wrong sides" so if you want one color for the front and a different one for the back, place the back color on top of the front color. Slip stitch or whip stitch around. Leave a small opening to stuff fiberfill. Stuff firmly. Close opening.

For the seam shown above,

Lay Y's on top of each other and slip stitch around leaving a small opening for the stuffing. Once firmly stuffed, close opening.
