

# Alphabet Pillow Blocks

## Letter "E"

### Pattern by Kimberly Lewis

#### A Woven and Spun Creation

\*this letter was stitched together without flipping right side out\*

#### Materials

Worsted Weight Yarn

Size I Crochet hook ( a smaller hook will produce a tighter stitch and smaller letter)

Polyester Fiber Fill

Stitch Markers

Special Stitch Information: Double Foundation Chain - - chain 2, work one single crochet in the first chain made. Insert the hook under the left-handed thread of the last single crochet made, work another single crochet. Repeat step 2 as required. (this stitch will be done later in the project)

This letter is worked from the bottom up in 5 sections

Make 2

Section 1

Ch 44

Row 1 sc in first ch from hook and in each ch to end (43 sc) ch 1, turn, throughout

Row 2 2 sc in first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (46 sc)

Row 3 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc. (47 sc)

Row 4 sc in each sc to end (48sc )

Row 5 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (49 sc)

Row 6 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to end (50 sc)

Row 7 dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (49)

Row 8 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (49 sc)

Row 9 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (49 sc)

Row 10 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc. (48 sc)

Place 1<sup>st</sup> stitch marker in the first sc of this row

Row 11 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in next 19 sc (20 sc)

Row 12 dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (19 sc)

Row 13-14 sc in each sc to end (19 sc)

Row 15 Dec over first sc. sc in each sc to end (18 sc)

Row 16-22 sc in each sc to end (18 sc)  
Row 23 sc in each sc to end, ch 16 (18 sc and 16 ch)  
Row 24 sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook and in each ch and sc to end (33 sc)  
Place second stitch marker in first stitch of row 24  
Row 25-32 sc in each sc to end (33 sc)  
Place 3<sup>rd</sup> stitch marker in the first stitch of row 32  
Row 33 sc in first sc and in next 16 sc (17 sc)  
Row 34-40 sc in each sc to end (17 sc)  
Row 41 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to end (18 sc)  
Row 42 sc in each sc to end  
Row 43 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc. (19 sc)  
Row 44 2 sc in first sc, sc in each to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (21 sc)  
Row 45 2 sc in first 2 sc. sc to end. Work special stitch for 24 stitches (47 sc)  
Place 4<sup>th</sup> stitch marker in last stitch worked  
Row 46 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc. (48 sc)  
Row 47 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (48 sc)  
Row 48-49 sc in each sc to end (48 sc)  
Row 50 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (47 sc)  
Row 51 sc in each sc to end (47 sc)  
Row 52 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (45 sc)  
Row 53 repeat row 52 (43 sc)  
Row 54 repeat row 52 (41 sc)  
Finish off

Return to 1<sup>st</sup> marked stitch

Section 2

Row 1 join with sc in first sc. sc in next 14 sc (15 sc)  
Row 2 Dec over first 3 sc. sc in each sc to end (13 sc)  
Row 3 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (12 sc)  
Row 4 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (11 sc)  
Row 5 repeat row 3 (10 sc)  
Row 6 repeat row 4 (9 sc)  
Row 7 repeat row 3 (8 sc)  
Row 8 repeat row 4 (7 sc)  
Row 9 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (5)  
Row 10 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (4 sc)  
Finish off

Return to 2<sup>nd</sup> marked stitch

Section 3

Row 1 Join with sc in first sc. sc in next 10 sc. (11 sc)  
Row 2 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (9 sc)  
Row 3-4 sc in each sc to end (9 sc)  
Row 5 repeat row 2 (7 sc)

Row 6 sc in each sc to end (7 sc)  
Row 7 repeat row 2 5 sc)  
Finish off

Return to 3<sup>rd</sup> marked stitch  
Section 4

Row 1 join with sc in first sc. sc in next 9 sc (10 sc)  
Row 2 sc in each sc to end (10 sc)  
Row 3 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (8 sc)  
Row 4-5 sc in each sc to end (8 sc)  
Row 6 repeat row 3 (6 sc)  
Row 7 repeat row 3 (4 sc)  
Finish off

Return to 4<sup>th</sup> marked stitch  
Section 5

Row 1 join with sc in first sc. sc in in next 14 ac (15 sc)  
Row 2 Dec over first 3 sc. sc in each sc to end (13 sc)  
Row 3 sc in each sc to last 3 sc. Dec over last 3 sc (11 sc)  
Row 4 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (10 sc)  
Row 5 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (8 sc)  
Row 6 repeat row 5 (6 sc)  
Row 7 repeat row 5 ( 4 sc)  
Finish off

Instructions for an "invisible seam"

When done with both letters, lay one on top of the other. You will be working the "wrong sides" so if you want one color for the front and a different one for the back, place the back color on top of the front color. Slip stitch or whip stitch around. Leave a small opening to stuff fiberfill. Stuff firmly. Close opening.

For the seam shown above,

Lay E's on top of each other and slip stitch around leaving a small opening for the stuffing. Once firmly stuffed, close opening.
