Letter "G"
Pattern by Kimberly Lewis
A Woven and Spun Creation



Materials

Worsted Weight Yarn

Size I Crochet hook (a smaller hook will produce a tighter stitch and smaller letter)

Polyester Fiber Fill

Stitch Markers

This letter is worked from the bottom up in 3 sections.

Make 2

Section 1

Ch 20

Row 1 sc in first ch from hook and in each ch across (19 sc) ch1, turn throughout.

Row 2 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. 2 sc in last 2 sc. (22 sc)

Row 3 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. 2 sc in last 2 sc. (25 sc)

Row 4 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. 2 sc in last 2 sc. (28 sc)

Row 5 2 sc in first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc. (31 sc)

Row 6 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc. (33 sc)

Row 7 2 sc in first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. 2 sc in last 2 sc ((37 sc)

Row 8 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc. (39 sc)

Row 9 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (41 sc)

Row 10 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc. (42 sc)
Row 11 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (44 sc)
Row 12 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc. Place Stitch Marker in FIRST sc worked on this row (46 sc)
Row 13 2 sc in first sc. sc in next 22 sc (24 sc)
Row 14 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc. (24 sc)
Row 15 sc in each sc to last 3 sc. Dec over last 3 sc. (22 sc)
Row 16 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc. (22 sc)
Row 17 sc in each sc to end (22 sc)
Row 18 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc. (22 sc)
Row 19 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (21 sc)
Row 20 sc in each sc to end (21 sc)
Row 21 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (21 sc)
Row 22 sc in each sc to end (21 sc)
Row 23 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (20 sc)
Row 24-25 sc in each sc to end (20 sc)
Row 26 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (19 sc)
Row 27-34 sc in each sc to end (19 sc)
Row 35 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (18 sc)
Row 36 sc in each sc to end (18 sc)
Row 37 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (19 sc)
Row 38 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (18 sc)
Row 39 sc in each sc to end (18 sc)
Row 40 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (18 sc)
Row 41 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc. (19 sc)
Row 42 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (18 sc)
Row 43 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (19 sc)
Row 44 2 sc in first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last sc. Dec over last sc (20 sc)
Row 45 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 3 sc. 2 sc in next 3 sc. ch 26 (21 sc and 26 ch)
Row 46 sc in first sc from hook and in each ch and sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc. (45 sc)
Place SECOND stitch marker in first sc worked on this row
Row 47 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (44 sc)
Row 48 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (42 sc)
Row 49 Dec over first 3 sc. sc in each sc to end (40 sc)
Row 50 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc. (38 sc)
Row 51 Dec over first 3 sc. sc in each sc end (36 sc)
Row 52 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 3 sc. Dec over last 3 sc (33 sc)
Row 53 Dec over first 3 sc. sc in each sc to last 3 sc. Dec over last 3 sc. (29 sc)
Row 54 Dec over first 3 sc. sc in each sc to last 3 sc. Dec over last 3 sc. (25 sc)

Finish off

Section 2

Return to SECOND marked stitch.

Row 1 join on underside of row previously worked (you will be working in the bottom part of the chain stitches for this row)

2 sc in first sc. sc in next 20 sc (22 sc)

Row 2 Dec over first 3 sc. sc in each sc to end (20 sc)

Row 3 sc in each sc to last 3 sc. Dec over last 3 sc (18 sc)

Row 4 Dec over first 3 sc. sc in each sc to end (16 sc)

Row 5 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc. (15 sc)

Row 6 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc. (13 sc)

Row 7 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc. (12 sc)

Row 8 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (11 sc)

Row 9 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (9 sc)

Row 10 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (7 sc)

Row 11 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (5 sc)

Finish off

Section 3

Return to FIRST marked stitch on row 12

Row 13 join with sc and sc in next 15 sc (16 sc)

Row 14 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc. (16 sc)

Row 15 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc. (15 sc)

Row 16 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (16 sc)

Row 17 sc in each sc to end (16 sc)

Row 18 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to end. Ch 5 (17 sc and 5 ch)

Row 19 sc in first ch from hook and in each ch and sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc. ch 6 (22 sc 6 ch)

Row 20 sc in first ch from hook and in each ch and sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (28 sc)

Row 21 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (30 sc)

Row 22-25 sc in each sc to end (30 sc)

Row 26 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc. (28 sc)

Row 27 Dec over first 3 sc. sc in each sc to last 3 sc. Dec over last 3 sc. (24 sc)

Row 28 Dec over first 3 sc. sc in each sc to last 3 sc. Dec over last 3 sc. (20 sc)

Finish Off

Instructions for an "invisible seam"

When done with both letters, lay one on top of the other. You will be working the "wrong sides" so if you want one color for the front and a different one for the back, place the back color on top of the front color. Slip stitch or whip stitch around. Leave a small opening to stuff fiberfill. Stuff firmly. Close opening. You will find it easier to work the outside of the letter, turn and then work the inside part of the letter.

For the seam shown above,

Lay G's on top of each other and slip stitch around leaving a small opening for the stuffing. Once firmly stuffed, close opening.
