Letter "H"  
Pattern by Kimberly Lewis  
A Woven and Spun Creation



\*this letter was stitched together without flipping right side\*

Materials

Worsted Weight Yarn

Size I Crochet hook ( a smaller hook will produce a tighter stitch and smaller letter)

Polyester Fiber Fill

Stitch Markers

Special Stitch Information: Double Foundation Chain - - chain 2, work one single crochet in the first chain made. Insert the hook under the left-handed thread of the last single crochet made, work another single crochet. Repeat step 2 as required. (this stitch will be done later in the project)

This letter is worked from the bottom up in 4 sections.

Make 2

Section 1

You will work from the bottom up the first part of the H stem

## Ch 21

Row 1 sc in first ch from hook and in each ch to end (20 sc) ch1, turn throughout

Row 2 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (22 sc)

Row 3 2 sc in first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. 2 sc in last 2 sc (26 sc)

Row 4 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (28 sc)

Row 5-8 sc in each sc to end (28 sc)

Row 9 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (26 sc)

Row 10 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 3 sc. Dec over last 3 sc (23 sc)

Row 11 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (21 sc)

Row 12 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (20 sc)

Row 13 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (19 sc)

Row 14 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (18 sc)

Row 15-22 sc in each sc to end (18 sc)

Row 23 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc. do special stitch for 31 stitches (19 sc and 31 special stitches)

Place marker in 1<sup>st</sup> stitch of this row.

## Section 2

You will now work in the underside of the previous row to work DOWN the opposite stem of the letter.

Row 1 sc in 19 sc (19 sc)

Row 2 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (18 sc)

Row 3-10 sc in each sc to end (18 sc)

Row 11 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (19 sc)

Row 12 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to end (20 sc)

Row 13 sc in each sc to end (20 sc)

Row 14 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (22 sc)

Row 15 2 sc in first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (25 sc)

Row 16 2 sc in first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (27 sc)

Row 17-20 sc in each sc to end (27 sc)

Row 21 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (25 sc)

Row 22 Dec over first 3 sc. sc in each sc to last 3 sc. Dec over last 3 sc. (21 sc)

Row 23 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (19 sc)

Finish off

## Section 3

Resume working upwards starting at marked stitch on row 23

Row 24 join with sc and sc in each sc to end (50 sc)

Row 25 -33 sc in each sc to end (50 sc)

Place stitch marker in first stitch of row 33

Row 34 sc in next 19 sc (19 sc)

Row 35 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (18 sc)

Row 36-42 sc in each sc to end (18 sc)  
Row 43 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (20 sc)  
Row 44 sc in each sc to end (20 sc)  
Row 45 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. 2 sc in last 2 sc (23 sc)  
Row 46 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. 2 sc in last 2 sc (26 sc)  
Row 47 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (28 sc)  
Row 48-51 sc in each sc to end (28 sc)  
Row 52-54 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (end with 22 sc)  
Finish off

#### Section 4

Return to marked stitch on row 33  
Row 34 join with sc and sc in next 18 sc (19 sc)  
Row 35 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (18 sc)  
Row 36-42 sc in each sc to end (18 sc)  
Row 43 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (20 sc)  
Row 44 sc in each sc to end (20 sc)  
Row 45 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc. (22 sc)  
Row 46 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. 2 sc in last 2 sc (25 sc)  
Row 47 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (27 sc)  
Row 48-51 sc in each sc to end (27 sc)  
Row 52-54 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (end with 21 sc)  
Finish off

#### Instructions for an "invisible seam"

When done with both letters, lay one on top of the other. You will be working the "wrong sides" so if you want one color for the front and a different one for the back, place the back color on top of the front color. Slip stitch or whip stitch around. Leave a small opening to stuff fiberfill. Stuff firmly. Close opening.

For the seam shown above,

Lay H's on top of each other and slip stitch around leaving a small opening for the stuffing. Once firmly stuffed, close opening.
