

Alphabet Pillow Blocks  
Letter "K"  
Pattern by Kimberly Lewis  
A Woven and Spun Creation



Materials

Worsted Weight Yarn

Size I Crochet hook ( a smaller hook will produce a tighter stitch and smaller letter)

Polyester Fiber Fill

Stitch Markers

Special Stitch Information: Double Foundation Chain - - chain 2, work one single crochet in the first chain made. Insert the hook under the left-handed thread of the last single crochet made, work another single crochet. Repeat step 2 as required. (this stitch will be done later in the project)

This letter is worked in three sections. You will work from bottom up starting from the left side. Continue working up the main "stem" of the K. You will then work the lower right slant of the K then work the upper right slant of the K.

Make 2

Chain 23

Row 1 1 sc in first ch from hook and in each ch across. (22 sc). Ch1, turn throughout

Row 2 2 sc in first sc, sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (24 sc)

Row 3 repeat row 2 (26 sc)

Row 4 repeat row 2 (28 sc)

Row 5-7 sc in each sc across (28 sc)

Row 8 sc in eac sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (27 sc)

Row 9 Dec over first 2 sc, sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (25 sc)

Row 10 repeat row 9 (23 sc)

Row 11 repeat row 9 (21 sc)

Row 12 Dec over first 2 sc, sc in each sc to end (20 sc)

Row 13-16 sc in each sc across (20 sc) ch 30

Row 17 sc in 1<sup>st</sup> ch from hook (place marker in chain area). Sc in next 28 ch and in each sc across (49 sc)

Row 18 Dec over first 2 sc, sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (47 sc)

Row 19 Dec over first 2 sc, sc in each sc to end (46 sc)

Row 20 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (45 sc)

Row 21 repeat row 19 (44 sc)

Row 22 repeat row 20 (43 sc)

Row 23 repeat row 19 (42 sc)

Row 24 repeat row 20 (41 sc)

Row 25 repeat row 19 (40 sc)

Row 26 repeat row 20 (39 sc)

Row 27 repeat row 19 (38 sc)

Row 28 repeat row 20 (37 sc)

Row 29 repeat row 19 (36 sc)

Row 30 repeat row 20 (35 sc)

Row 31 repeat row 19 (34 sc)

Row 32 repeat row 20 (33 sc)

Row 33-37 sc in each sc to end (33 sc) Place second stitch marker on the first stitch on row 37

Row 38 2 sc in first sc, sc in next 17 sc (19 sc)

Row 39-41 sc in each sc to end (19 sc)

Row 42 2 sc in first sc, sc to last sc, 2 sc in last sc (21 sc)

Row 43 sc in each sc to end. (21 sc)

Row 44 2 sc in first 2 sc, sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (24 sc)

Row 45 repeat row 42 (26 sc)

Row 46 repeat row 42 (28 sc)

Row 47-50 sc in each sc across (28 sc)

Row 51 Dec over first 2 sc, sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (26 sc)  
Row 52 repeat row 51 (24 sc)  
Row 53 repeat row 51 (22 sc)  
Row 54 repeat row 51 (20 sc)  
Finish off

Return to first stitch marker.

Row 1 join with sc in stitch with first marker, sc in same st. sc in next 25 sc (27 sc)  
Row 2 dec over first 2 sc, sc to last sc, 2 sc in last sc (27 sc)  
Row 3 2 sc in first sc, sc to last 2 sc, Dec over last 2 sc (27 sc)  
Row 4 dec over first 2 sc, sc to last sc, 2 sc in last sc (27 sc)  
Row 5 2 sc in first sc, sc to last 2 sc, Dec over last 2 sc (27 sc)  
Row 6 dec over first 2 sc, sc to last sc, 2 sc in last sc (27 sc)  
Row 7 2 sc in first sc, sc to last 2 sc, Dec over last 2 sc (27 sc)  
Row 8 dec over first 2 sc, sc to last sc, 2 sc in last sc (27 sc)  
Row 9 2 sc in first sc, sc to end (28 sc)  
Row 10 dec over first 2 sc, sc to end (27 sc)  
Row 11 sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (26 sc)  
Row 12 Repeat row 10 (25 sc)  
Row 13 Repeat row 11 (24 sc)  
Row 14 Dec over first 2 sc, sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (22 sc)  
Row 15 repeat row 14 (20 sc)  
Row 16 Repeat row 14 (18 sc)  
Finish Off

Return to second stitch marker

Row 1 join with sc with second stitch marker, sc in same stitch, sc in next 11 sc (13 sc)  
Row 2 Dec over first 2 sc, sc to last sc, 2 sc in last sc (13 sc)  
Row 3 2 sc in first sc, sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (13 sc)  
Row 4 repeat row 2 (13 sc)  
Row 5 2 sc in first 2 sc, sc to last 2 sc. Dec in last 2 sc (14 sc)  
Row 6 sc in next 14 sc, do Double Foundation Chain for 7 stitches, ch 1, turn.  
Row 7 2 sc in first stitch, sc in each sc to end (23 sc)  
Row 8 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (24 sc)  
Row 9 2 sc in first sc, sc to last sc, 2 sc in last sc (26 sc)  
Row 10 sc in each sc to last sc, 2 sc in last sc (27 sc)  
Row 11-13 sc in each sc to end (27 sc)  
Row 14 Dec over first 2 sc, sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (25 sc)  
Row 15 Dec over first 2 sc, sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (23 sc)  
Row 16 Dec over first 2 sc, sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (21 sc)  
Row 17 Dec over first 2 sc, sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (19 sc)  
Finish Off

When done with both letters, lay one on top of the other. You will be working the "wrong sides" so if you want one color for the front and a different one for the back, place the back color on top of the front color. Slip stitch or whip stitch around. Leave a small opening to stuff fiberfill. Stuff firmly. Close opening.
