Letter "L"  
Pattern by Kimberly Lewis  
A Woven and Spun Creation



\*this letter was stitched together without flipping right side\*

Materials

Worsted Weight Yarn

Size I Crochet hook ( a smaller hook will produce a tighter stitch and smaller letter)

Polyester Fiber Fill

Stitch Markers

This letter is worked from the bottom up in 2 sections.

Make 2

Section 1

Ch 43

Row 1 sc in first ch from hook and in each ch to end ch 1, turn throughout (42sc)

Row 2 2 sc in first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. 2 sc in last 2 sc. (44 sc)

Row 3 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (45 sc)

Row 4 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc (46 sc )

Row 5 sc in each sc to end. (46 sc)

Row 6 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to end (47 sc)

Row 7 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (48 sc)

Row 8 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to end (49 sc)

Row 9-10 sc in each sc to end (49 sc)

Place stitch marker in first stitch or row 10

Row 11 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in next 26 sc (27 sc)

Row 12 Dec over first 2 sc. sc to last 3 sc. dec over last 3 sc. (24 sc)

Row 13 Dec over first 3 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (21 sc)

Row 14 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (20 sc)

Row 15 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (18 sc)

Row 16-43 sc in each sc to end (18 sc)

Row 44 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc. (20 sc)

Row 45 2 sc in first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. 2 sc in last 2 sc (24 sc)

Row 46 repeat row 45 (28 sc)

Row 47 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (30 sc)

Row 48 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 s in last sc (32 sc)

Row 49-51 sc in each sc to end (32 sc)

Row 52 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (30 sc)

Row 53-54 repeat row 52 (26 sc)

Finish off

Return to marked stitch on row 10

Row 11 join with sc in marked stitch. sc in next 13 sc (14 sc)

Row 12 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (13 sc)

Row 13 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (12 sc)

Row 14 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last sc (11 sc)

Row 15 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc. (10 sc)

Row 16 -17 sc in each sc to end (10 sc)

Row 18 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (9 sc)

Row 19 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (8 sc)

Row 20 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (6 sc)

Finish off

Instructions for an "invisible seam"

When done with both letters, lay one on top of the other. You will be working the "wrong sides" so if you want one color for the front and a different one for

the back, place the back color on top of the front color. Slip stitch or whip stitch around. Leave a small opening to stuff fiberfill. Stuff firmly. Close opening.

For the seam shown above,

Lay L's on top of each other and slip stitch around leaving a small opening for the stuffing. Once firmly stuffed, close opening.
