A Woven and Spun Creation



this letter was stitched together without flipping right side out

Materials

Worsted Weight Yarn

Size I Crochet hook (a smaller hook will produce a tighter stitch and smaller letter)

Polyester Fiber Fill

Stitch Markers

This letter is worked from the bottom up in 3 sections.

Make 2

Section 1

Ch 16

Row 1 sc in first ch from hook and in each ch to end (15 sc)

Row 2 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (17 sc)

Row 3 2 sc in first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. 2 sc in last 2 sc. (21 sc)

Row 4 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc. (23 sc)

Row 5-8 sc in each sc to end. (23 sc)

Row 9 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (22 sc)

Row 10 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc. (20 sc)

Row 11 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 3 sc. Dec over last 3 sc (17 sc)

Row 12 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (15 sc)
Row 13 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc. (13 sc)
Row 14-24 sc in each sc to end. (13 sc)
Row 25 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc. Ch 37 (14 sc 37 ch)
Row 26 sc in first ch from hook and in each ch. Sc in each sc to end (50 sc)
Place 1st stitch marker at the beginning of row 26.
Row 27-32 sc in each sc in each sc to end (50 sc)
Place 2nd stitch marker at the beginning of row 32
Row 33 sc in first sc and in next 35 sc. (36 sc)
Row 34 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (35 sc)
Row 35 sc in each sc to last 3 sc. Dec over last 3 sc (33 sc)
Row 36 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (32 sc)
Row 37 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (31 sc)
Row 38 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (30 sc)
Row 39 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (29 sc)
Row 40 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (28 sc)
Row 41 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (28 sc)
Row 42 Dec over first 3 sc. sc in each sc to end (26 sc)
Row 43 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (26 sc)
Row 44 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. 2 sc in last 2 sc. (27 sc)
Row 45 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (27 sc)
Row 46 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc. (27 sc)
Row 47 sc in each sc to last 3 sc. Dec over last 3 sc (25 sc)
Row 48 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (24 sc)
Row 49 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (23 sc)
Row 50 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (22 sc)
Row 51 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (21 sc)
Row 52 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (19 sc)
Row 53 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (17 sc)
Row 54 Dec over first 3 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (14 sc)

Section 2

Return to 1st stitch marker.

You will now work on the underside of the row already completed.

Row 1 Join with sc in first sc. sc in next 34 sc (35 sc) *note..there will be one skipped stitch on this row*

Row 2 Dec over first 3 sc. sc in each sc to end (33 sc)
Row 3 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (32 sc)
Row 4 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (31 sc)
Row 5 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (30 sc)
Row 6 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (29 sc)
Row 7 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (28 sc)
Row 8 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (27 sc)
Row 9 sc in each sc to last 3 sc. Dec over last 3 sc (25 sc)

Row 10 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (24 sc)
Row 11 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (23 sc)
Row 12 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (22 sc)
Row 13 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (21 sc)
Row 14 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (20 sc)
Row 15 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (19 sc)
Row 16 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (18 sc)
Row 17 sc in each sc to last 3 sc. Dec over last 3 sc (16 sc)
Row 18 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (15 sc)
Row 19 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (14 sc)
Row 20 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (13 sc)
Row 21 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (11 sc)
Row 22 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (10 sc)
Row 23 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (9 sc)
Row 24 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (7 sc)
Row 25 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (5 sc)
Finish off

Section 3

Return to 2nd marked stitch

Row 33 join with sc in first sc. sc in next 12 sc (13 sc)
Row 34 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (12 sc)
Row 35-43 sc in each sc to end (12 sc)
Row 44 2 sc in first sc. sc in last sc. 2 sc in last sc (14 sc)
Row 45 2 sc in first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. 2 sc in last 2 sc (18 sc)
Row 46 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (20 sc)
Row 47 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (22 sc)
Row 48-51 sc in each sc to end (22 sc)
Row 52 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (21 sc)
Row 53 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (19 sc)
Row 54 Dec over first 3 sc. sc in each sc to last 3 sc. Dec over last 3 sc (15 sc)
Finish off

Instructions for an "invisible seam"

When done with both letters, lay one on top of the other. You will be working the "wrong sides" so if you want one color for the front and a different one for the back, place the back color on top of the front color. Slip stitch or whip stitch around. Leave a small opening to stuff fiberfill. Stuff firmly. Close opening.

For the seam shown above,

Lay N's on top of each other and slip stitch around leaving a small opening for the stuffing. Once firmly stuffed, close opening.
