A Woven and Spun Creation



\*this letter was stitched together without flipping right side out\*

Materials

Worsted Weight Yarn

Size I Crochet hook ( a smaller hook will produce a tighter stitch and smaller letter)

Polyester Fiber Fill

Stitch Markers

This letter is worked from the bottom up in 3 sections.

Special Stitch Information: Double Foundation Chain - - chain 2, work one single crochet in the first chain made. Insert the hook under the left-handed thread of the last single crochet made, work another single crochet. Repeat step 2 as required. (this stitch will be done later in the project)

Section 1

Ch 19

Row 1 sc in first ch from hook and in each ch to end (18 sc)

Row 2 2 sc in first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. 2 sc in last 2 sc. (22 sc)  
Row 3 2 sc in first 3 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. 2 sc in last 2 sc (27 sc)  
Row 4 2 sc in first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. 2 sc in last 2 sc (31)  
Row 5 2 sc in first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. 2 sc in last 2 sc (35 sc)  
Row 6 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (37 sc)  
Row 7 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. 2 sc in last 2 sc. (39 sc)  
Row 8 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (41 sc)  
Row 9 sc in each sc to end (41 sc)  
Row 10 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (43 sc)  
Row 11 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (44 sc)  
Place stitch marker in first sc of row 11  
Row 12 sc in first sc and in next 20 sc (21 sc)  
Row 13 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (21 sc)  
Row 14 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (20 sc)  
Row 15 sc in each sc to end (20 sc)  
Row 16 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (22 sc)  
Row 17 2 sc in first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (24 sc)  
Row 18 sc in each sc to last sc. work special stitch for 3 stitches (27 sc)  
Row 19 2 sc in first 3 sc. sc in each sc to end (30 sc)  
Row 20 sc in each sc to end. Work special stitch for 3 stitches (33 sc)  
Row 21 2 sc in first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (35 sc)  
Row 22 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. 2 sc in last 2 sc (37 sc)  
Row 23 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to end (38 sc)  
Row 24 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (38 sc)  
Row 25 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to end (39 sc)  
Row 26 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (39 sc)  
Row 27 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to end (40 sc)  
Row 28 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (40 sc)  
Row 29 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (40 sc)  
Row 30 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (39 sc)  
Row 31 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (39 sc)  
Row 32 Dec over first 3 sc. sc in each sc to end (37 sc)  
Row 33 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (36 sc)  
Row 34 Dec over first 3 sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (35 sc)  
Row 35 sc in each sc to last 4 sc. Dec over last 4 sc (32 sc)  
Row 36 Dec over first 4 sc. sc in each sc to end (29 sc)  
Row 37 sc in each sc to last 4 sc. Dec over last 4 sc (26 sc)  
Row 38 Dec over first 4 sc. sc in each sc to end (23 sc)  
Row 39 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (22 sc)  
Row 40 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (20 sc)  
Row 41 sc in each sc to end (20 sc)  
Row 42 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to end (21 sc)  
Row 43 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc. ch 23 (21 sc/ 23 ch)

Row 44 sc in first ch from hook and in each of the next 21 ch. Sc in each sc to end (43 sc )

Place 2<sup>nd</sup> stitch marker in first ch worked on Row 44

Row 45 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (41 sc)

Row 46 sc in each sc to end (41 sc)

Row 47 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (39 s)

Row 48 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc. (38 sc)

Row 49 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (36 sc)

Row 50 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 3 sc. Dec over last 3 sc. (33 sc)

Row 51 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc. (31 sc)

Row 52 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 3 sc. Dec over last 3 sc. (28 sc)

Row 53 Dec over first 3 sc. sc in each sc to last 3 sc. Dec over last 3 sc (24 sc)

Row 54 repeat row 53 (20 sc)

Finish off

## Section 2

Return to 1<sup>st</sup> stitch marker.

Row 12. join with sc in first sc. sc in next 14 sc (15 sc)

Row 13 Dec over first 3 sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (14 sc)

Row 14 sc in each sc to last 3 sc. Dec over last 3 sc. (12 sc)

Row 15 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (11 sc)

Row 16 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (10 sc)

Row 17 sc in each sc to end (10 sc)

Row 18 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc. (9 sc)

Row 19 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (8 sc)

Row 20 sc in each sc to end (8 sc)

Row 21 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (7 sc)

Row 22 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (5 sc)

Finish Off

## Section 3

Return to 2<sup>nd</sup> stitch marker

Row 1 join with sc in underside of first ch worked. Sc in next 16 sc (17 sc)

Row 2 Dec over first 3 sc. sc in each sc to end (15 sc)

Row 3 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc. (14 sc)

Row 4 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (13 sc)

Row 5 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (12 sc)

Row 6 Dec over first 3 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (9 sc)

Row 7 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (8 sc)

Row 8 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (6 sc)  
Finish Off

Instructions for an "invisible seam"

When done with both letters, lay one on top of the other. You will be working the "wrong sides" so if you want one color for the front and a different one for the back, place the back color on top of the front color. Slip stitch or whip stitch around. Leave a small opening to stuff fiberfill. Stuff firmly. Close opening.

For the seam shown above,

Lay S's on top of each other and slip stitch around leaving a small opening for the stuffing. Once firmly stuffed, close opening.
