

Alphabet Pillow Blocks
Letter "T"
Pattern by Kimberly Lewis
A Woven and Spun Creation



this letter was stitched together without flipping right side out

Materials

Worsted Weight Yarn

Size I Crochet hook (a smaller hook will produce a tighter stitch and smaller letter)

Polyester Fiber Fill

Stitch Markers

This letter is worked from top down in 3 sections

Make 2

Section 1

Ch 41

Row 1 sc in first ch from hook and in each ch across (40 sc)

Row 2 2 sc in first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. 2 sc in last 2 sc (44)

Row 3 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (46 sc)

Row 4 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (48 sc)

Row 5 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (50 sc)

Row 6 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (52 sc)

Row 7 sc in each sc to end (52 sc)

Row 8 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (54 sc)

Row 9 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (56 sc)

Row 10-13 sc in each sc to end (56 sc)
Place stitch marker in first sc on row 13
Row 14 sc in first sc and in next 13 sc (14 sc)
Row 15 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (13 sc)
Row 16 sc in each sc to end (13 sc)
Row 17 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (12 sc)
Row 18 sc in each sc to end (12 sc)
Row 19 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (10 sc)
Row 20 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (8 sc)
Row 21 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (6 sc)
Finish off.

Section 2

Return to marked stitch.

Row 14 join with sc in marked sc. sc in next 14 sc (15 sc)
Mark last stitch at end of this row
Row 15 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (14 sc)
Row 16 sc in each sc to end (14 sc)
Row 17 Dec over first sc. sc in each sc to end (13 sc)
Row 18 sc in each sc to end (13 sc)
Row 19 Dec over first sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (11 sc)
Row 20 Dec over first sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (9 sc)
Row 21 Dec over first 3 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (6 sc)

Section 3

Return to marked stitch.

Count over 4 sc from marked stitch.

Row 14 Join with sc. sc in next 20 sc (21 sc)
*note you should have 3 skipped stitches on either side of this row
Row 15-42 sc in each sc to end (21 sc)
Row 43 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (23 sc)
Row 44 2 sc in first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. 2 sc in last 2 sc (27 sc)
Row 45 2 sc in first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. 2 sc in last 2 sc (31 sc)
Row 46 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc. (33 sc)
Row 47-51 sc in each sc to end (33 sc)
Row 52 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (31 sc)
Row 53 Dec over first 3 sc. sc in each sc to last 3 sc. Dec over last 3 sc (27 sc)
Row 54 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (25 sc)
Finish Off

Instructions for an "invisible seam"

When done with both letters, lay one on top of the other. You will be working the "wrong sides" so if you want one color for the front and a different one for

the back, place the back color on top of the front color. Slip stitch or whip stitch around. Leave a small opening to stuff fiberfill. Stuff firmly. Close opening.

For the seam shown above,

Lay E's on top of each other and slip stitch around leaving a small opening for the stuffing. Once firmly stuffed, close opening.
