this letter was stitched together without flipping right side out

Materials

Worsted Weight Yarn

Size I Crochet hook (a smaller hook will produce a tighter stitch and smaller letter)

Polyester Fiber Fill

Stitch Markers

Special Stitch Information: Double Foundation Chain - - chain 2, work one single crochet in the first chain made. Insert the hook under the left-handed thread of the last single crochet made, work another single crochet. Repeat step 2 as required. (this stitch will be done later in the project)

This letter is worked from the bottom up in _6_ sections.

Make 2

Section 1

You will be working the first part of the w stem from bottom up

Ch 7

Row 1 sc in first ch from hook and in each ch to end ch 1, turn throughout (6sc)

Row 2 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (8 sc)

Row 3 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (10 sc)
Row 4 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to end (11 sc)
Row 5 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to end (12 sc)
Row 6 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to end (13 sc)
Row 7 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to end (14 sc)
Row 8 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to end (15 sc)
Row 9 sc in each sc across (15 sc)
Row 10 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (16 sc)
Row 11 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (17 sc)
Row 12 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (18 sc)
Row 13 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (19 sc)
Row 14 sc in each sc to end (19 sc)
Row 15 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to end (20 sc)
Row 16 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to end (21 sc)
Row 17 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to end (22 sc)
Row 18 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to end (23 sc)
Row 19 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to end (24 sc)
Row 20 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to end (25 sc)
Row 21 sc in each sc to end (25 sc)
Row 22 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (26 sc)
Row 23 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (27 sc)
Row 24 sc in each sc to end (27 sc)
Row 25 sc in each sc to end then do special stitch for 31 stitches. (27 sc and 31 special stitches)
Place a marker in the first sc on Row 25

Section 2

You will now be working down the opposite side of the Foundation Row just made

Row 1 sc in next 28 stitches (28 sc)
Row 2 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (27 sc)
Row 3 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (26 sc)
Row 4 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (25 sc)
Row 5 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (24 sc)
Row 6 sc in each sc to end (24 sc)
Row 7 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (23 sc)
Row 8 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (22 sc)
Row 9 sc in each sc to end (22 sc)
Row 10 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (21 sc)
Row 11 sc in each sc to end (21 sc)
Row 12 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (19 sc)
Row 13 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (18 sc)
Row 14 sc in each sc to end (18 sc)

Row 15 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (16 sc)
Row 16 sc in each sc to end (16 sc)
Row 17 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (14 sc)
Row 18 sc in each sc to end (14 sc)
Row 19 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (13 sc)
Row 20 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (12 sc)
Row 21 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (10 sc)
Row 22 sc in each sc to end (10 sc)
Row 23 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (8 sc)
Row 24 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (6 sc)
Finish off

Section 3

Return to marked stitch

You will now continue working up the letter at row 26

Row 26 2 sc in first sc and each sc to end (59 sc)
Row 27 2 sc in first sc, sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (61 sc)
Row 28 sc in each sc to end (61 sc)
Row 29 2 sc in first sc, sc in each sc to end (62 sc)
Row 30 2 sc in first sc, sc in each sc to end (63 sc)
Place marker #1 in 1st sc of row.

Section 4

You are now working the center stem of the W

Row 31 sc in first sc and in next 39 sc (40 sc)
Place marker #2 first sc of this row
Row 32 sc in first sc and in next 27 sc (28 sc)
Row 33 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (26 sc)
Row 34 sc in each sc to end (26 sc)
Row 35 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (24 sc)
Row 36 sc in each sc to end (24 sc)
Row 37 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (23 sc)
Row 38 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (22 sc)
Row 39 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (21 sc)
Row 40 sc in each sc to end (21 sc)
Row 41 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (20 sc)
Row 42 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to end (21 sc)
Row 43 sc in each sc to end (21 sc)
Row 44 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (21 sc)
Row 45 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (22 sc)
Row 46 2 sc in first sc, sc in each sc to last sc, 2 sc in last sc (24 sc)
Row 47 2 sc in first sc, sc in each sc to last sc, 2 sc in last sc (26 sc)
Row 48 2 sc in first sc, sc in each sc to last sc, 2 sc in last sc (28 sc)
Row 49 2 sc in first sc, sc in each sc to end (29 sc)

Row 50 sc in each sc to end (29 sc)
Row 51 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (28 sc)
Row 52 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (27 sc)
Row 53 Dec over first 2 sc, sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (25 sc)
Row 54 Dec over first 2 sc, sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (23 sc)

Finish off

Section 5

Return to first marked stitch in row 30

Row 31 join with sc in marked stitch and sc in next 19 sc (20 sc)
Row 32 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (21 sc)
Row 33 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (20 sc)
Row 34 sc in each sc to end (20 sc)
Row 35 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc . Dec over last 2 sc (20 sc)
Row 36 sc in each sc to end (20 sc)
Row 37 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to end (21 sc)
Row 38 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (20 sc)
Row 39 sc in each sc to end (20 sc)
Row 40 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (20 sc)
Row 41 sc in each sc to end (20 sc)
Row 42 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (21 sc)
Row 43 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (20 sc)
Row 44 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (21 sc)
Row 45 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to end (22 sc)
Row 46 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (23 sc)
Row 47 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (25 sc)
Row 48 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to end (26 sc)
Row 49-51 sc in each sc to end (26 sc)
Row 52 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (24 sc)
Row 53 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (22 sc)
Row 54 Dec over first 3 sc. sc in each sc to last 3 sc. Dec over last 3 sc (18 sc)
Finish off

Section 6

Return to 2nd marked stitch on row 31.

Row 32 join with sc and sc in next 9 sc (10 sc)
Row 33 sc in each sc to end (10 sc)
Row 34 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (9 sc)
Row 35 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (10 sc)
Row 36 sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (9 sc)
Row 37 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (10 sc)
Row 38 sc in each sc to end (10 sc)
Row 39 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to end (9 sc)
Row 40 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to end (10 sc)

Row 41 sc in each sc to end (10 sc)
Row 42 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc (10 sc)
Row 43 sc in each sc to end (10 sc)
Row 44 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to end (11 sc)
Row 45 sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (12 sc)
Row 46 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (14 sc)
Row 47 2 sc in first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (17 sc)
Row 48 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to last sc. 2 sc in last sc (19 sc)
Row 49 2 sc in first sc. sc in each sc to end (20 sc)
Row 50-51 sc in each sc to end (20 sc)
Row 52 -54 Dec over first 2 sc. sc in each sc to last 2 sc. Dec over last 2 sc
(end with 14 sc)

Finish off

Instructions for an "invisible seam"

When done with both letters, lay one on top of the other. You will be working the "wrong sides" so if you want one color for the front and a different one for the back, place the back color on top of the front color. Slip stitch or whip stitch around. Leave a small opening to stuff fiberfill. Stuff firmly. Close opening.

For the seam shown above,

Lay L's on top of each other and slip stitch around leaving a small opening for the stuffing. Once firmly stuffed, close opening.
